What does the program look like?



25 Courses approved for Study of Ordination. All DMTC courses are heavily subsidized by the Canada Central District.

The academic requirements to apply for a district license are a minimum of six completed courses. These courses must include THE 2013 (The Doctrine of Holiness) and PAS 2023 (History and Polity of the Church of the Nazarene).

Past transcripts may be submitted for assessment to the Board of Ministry.

The Nazarene Bible College Alliance

The District Ministry Training Centre (DMTC) provides instruction to students in a classroom setting or through structures which best meet the educational needs of the students.

NBC provides support to member DMTCs and provides accountability for each course that is taught.

All instructors are approved to teach in their subject areas and every syllabus is approved by NBC.

Students create a Student Academic Portfolio (see next slide) through which students may be granted NBC college credit for work completed at a DMTC.

We recommend every student keep a portfolio for every course, in case they one day wish to apply for a credit.

DMTC Courses are for ordination credit only, but with the portfolio system you can work with NBC to receive a BA Degree Credit.

The Portfolio System

The Student Academic Portfolio is a well-organized compilation of course materials (exams, papers, projects, class notes, etc.) that demonstrates academic work was college level quality and the content and extent of learning was enough to be acceptable as college credit.

Your portfolio should include

- Course Syllabus
- Assignments
- Exams/tests/quizzes
- Class notes

Each syllabus includes everything you need to know about the Student Academic Portfolio on the last page.

Option for a BA Degree Credit

If a student decides they want to pursue a BA degree in ministry, NBC will receive the student portfolio to assess credit.

The fee is \$60 USD to have a course assessed for credit.

Students will only be given credit when a complete portfolio is submitted and approved.









How Much Does the DMTC Cost?

\$150 per course (3 credit hours) plus text books The registration fees have been reduced to half the original cost. This is possible through the generous support of Canada Central District. Scholarships are available in limited circumstances.

\$150 to audit (no homework, no credit for ordination)

Free for lifelong learning credit for ordained clergy serving on Canada Central District
